Break during the day	The summer school program is not able to provide snacks. You are welcome to provide a snack for your child to eat during the daily break. Please refrain from bringing snacks that contain peanut or tree nut products.
Lunch	Lunch will not be provided. Students who sign up for Coding Camp will have a lunch break from 12:00-12:30 and will need to bring a home lunch on the day they have coding.
Student conduct	Any child who commits a Class A or Class B offense (Chapter 19) shall be dismissed from the program. For other misconduct, a student may be dismissed if behavior continues after receiving a consequence and/or counseling from the Summer School Director.

Submit your forms with payment (if applicable)

1. For 8am-12pm program: Submit registration and emergency forms.

OR

For 8am-12pm program and Coding Camp 12:30-2:00pm: Submit registration form, emergency form, and payment

- If withdrawing from a class, out of courtesy to others who may be on the waiting list, please notify the Summer School Director as soon as possible.

### **Waiting List**

- Parents will be notified by the Summer School Director if their child has been placed on the waiting list and will be contacted if space becomes available.

### **Cancellation**

- A class may be canceled depending on the enrollment and/or availability of teachers.
