Classroom assignments	Assignments will be shared with you in your confirmation letter; letters will be sent home by April 17. Assignments will also be posted inside the Office starting on June 3.
Attendance	Please ensure that your child is dropped off to make it to their classroom by 8:00am. If your child will be absent, please contact Summer School Director, Lisa Nakamura, or leave a message with the Office at 587-4500.
Break during the day	The summer school program is not able to provide snacks. You are welcome to provide a snack for your child to eat during the daily break. Please refrain from bringing snacks that contain peanut or tree nut products.
Lunch	Lunch will not be provided. Students who sign up for Animation/Coding will have a lunch break from 12:00-12:30 and will need to bring a home lunch on the day they have animation/coding.
Student conduct	Any child who commits a Class A or Class B offense (Chapter 19) shall be dismissed from the program. For other misconduct, a student may be dismissed if behavior continues after receiving a consequence and/or counseling from the Summer School Director.
